Parent Teacher Night – This year, Parent Teacher Night will be held on Wednesday, October 23rd from 5-7pm. This is a great opportunity to come meet teachers and get an update on your child's progress. 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Breakfast for Learning - our school offers quick and simple breakfast food options to get the day going from 8:05am-8:30am every morning. 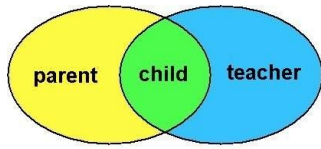
Code of conduct

Calling in Absences

At Lake City Secondary we feel regular attendance is a crucial component of academic performance. Students are expected to be on time and attend every class. Student Photo Retakes – is **Thursday October 3rd** for any students who need retakes or missed getting their picture taken the first time.

If a student likes their first picture (from seeing their ID card), but did not order a package then, they can come see Steeve (Photographer), give him the order package and tell him they want the picture from the first picture day.



If a student does not like their first picture, they can get retakes. If they already paid for a package, **they must bring those photos back** on retake day and give them to the photographer in order to get the new retakes. Absolutely no free retakes for students who chose to dress inappropriately their first photos. They must pay for another photo package.

Order forms and payment must be given directly to the photographer on retake day. We **cannot** accept them at the office.
