

Tips & Suggestions

Coordinate your outfits from head to toe.

Necklines – A V-neck is best for shorter necks and if your face is full. A collared shirt or blouse is better for a longer neck and slender facial features.

Cover-up – Make up should be applied evenly. If the blemishes are slightly visible don't worry, we can still retouch them. If your make-up is not even, skin will appear blotchy and uneven in the photographs.

These are your photographs, your memories, so we encourage you to bring some props for your photo sitting. Snowboards, sports equipment and uniforms and musical instruments are some suggestions. If you have any questions about what is allowed or what can be photographed talk to your grad sponsor or speak to the photographers the day before you sitting.

Your Sitting Fee

The sitting fee for your school is \$30.00. This is for your 12 previews, a 5x7 diploma folder with school logo and a 5x7 grad photo. We accept cash, cheques, Visa and MasterCard. Any students who do not bring their sitting fee will have their previews held until payment is made.

Your previews will be delivered to the school approximately 2 weeks after all students have been photographed. We will collect orders one week after preview delivery.

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Getting Ready

Be sure to arrive 10 minutes before for your appointment to sign in and complete the necessary paperwork.

After you check in, we will go over your complexion to make sure that you look your best in your photos. Be sure you are happy with your grooming before your appointment. Wash your face and neck to reduce glare from skin in your photographs. Don't worry about any new or un-expected blemishes, we will retouch your photos in your final package. Check your hair before starting your session as this is your responsibility along with any other fine details.

Your Photo Session

You will have 12 different photos taken, 10 formal gown photos and a couple of casuals (if you like). You will start with the casual photos so be sure to arrive in your casual clothes first. After your casual photos you will put on a grad gown and have the graduation photos taken. Your sitting should take about 10 - 15 minutes from start to finish.



Ladies

Be sure that you are happy with your hair before arriving. Try not to go to a new hair dresser just before coming in for your portrait session. Be sure to explain exactly what you would like done to your hair. Too many times do we hear girls say the hairdresser ruined their hair prior to their photo session.



Use your regular make up and be sure it is even on your face. We cannot retouch color variations between your neck and face. Heavy makeup is not necessary for photography, just look natural and your photographs will reflect that.

Bring your make up for any last minute touch ups you may need. Please wear a blouse or a V-neck shirt for the graduation gown photographs. We suggest a white or beige blouse with a small high collar for the traditional look or a V-neck top to achieve the bare neck look. Please, no tee shirts or hoodies.



Gentlemen



Try to get your hair cut 1 week before your photo session. Shave carefully to avoid nicks and cuts. If you get stubble in the early evening, shave a couple of hours prior to your session. Wash your face well to prevent glare.

Choose a fresh, clean, pressed white shirt. Other light colors or subtle patterns can look good, but white is the best choice. Choose a tie that will match or contrast the graduation gown and sash specific to your school. Please, no tee shirts or hoodies.
